Time: 8:00 AM – 7:30 PM both days.

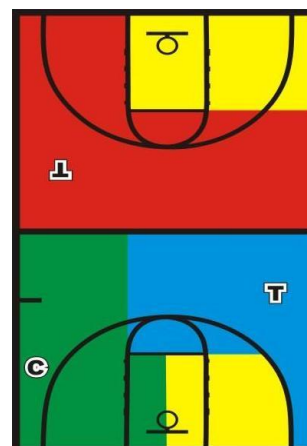
Where: St. Joseph High School, St. Joseph, Michigan. (Held in conjunction with the St. Joseph Summer Shootout.)

All court clinicians and class instructors are veteran, registered MHSAA officials with state post-season tournament experience. Several assignors from southwestern Michigan conferences will also be in attendance, either as clinicians, observers, or presenters.
